Unit 1

A natural disaster. Writing a text. Telling an anecdote. The Monarca butterfly. Recognizing main and secondary ideas. Reading and narrating a story. Writing a letter or e-mail. Mexico, a country of great diversity. The extinction of species. Writing a news headline. Expressing actions in progress that started in the past and still continue.

Unit 2

Traditional medicine. Beliefs and superstitions. Medicinal plants. Giving a description. Habits to stay healthy. Expressing obligation, need or convenience. First aid. Giving orders, suggestions and advice. A doctor's appointment. Body types. A balanced nutrition. Expressing conditions in the present. Vocabulary according to the similarity of words. Expressions and sayings related to eating habits.

Unit 3

Prehispanic games. Doing a summary. Expressing likes, dislikes and preferences. Sports and free time activities. Phrases and idioms typical of entertainment and sports. Olympic sports. Slowly and fast. Arguing. Expressing actions that involve acts of will, hopes and wishes. The Raramuris. Sports and money.

Unit 4

Foreign immigrants and their integration in Mexico. Placing an action in time. Writing a letter. Colloquial phrases. Describing objects and situations, specifying their meaning. Writing a notice. Alternative ways to express an opinion. Famous foreigners in Mexico. Listening and Reading comprehension. Composition.

Unit 5

Sociocultural aspects of the Mexico Valley. Synonyms and antonyms. Writing a tourist brochure. The Mexican southeast. The Chocolate. Writing a script.

Scope

After finishing the level 5 B1 CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference)

- Can understand the main ideas of clear texts written in standard language if they deal with matters that are known to them, in a work, study or leisure situation.
- Can interact in most situations that might come up during a trip in areas where the language is spoken.
- Can produce simple and coherent texts about topics that are familiar or of personal interest to them
- Can describe experiences, accounts, wishes and aspirations, as well as briefly support their opinions or explaining their plans
